

Don Lent is the Dana Professor of Art Emeritus at Bates College. He holds degrees from Yale University and the University of California. Don has had a long career of teaching and exhibiting his art. He has taught at the University of California Santa Barbara , Bowdoin College as well as Bates.

His work has been shown at the Grolier Society and the Barone Gallery in New York, Harvard University, the Boston Architecture Center and the Martin Village Gallery in London. Both Bates College and Bowdoin College have given him solo exhibitions and published catalogues of his work. The New York Public Library chose his book of etchings, the Heat Lightning for its exhibition, "Sixty books from the Sixties." In addition He has had more than 20 solo shows throughout the country and has participated in countless group shows here and abroad.
